

Vacation Care Program

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Program

- Our service operates between 6.30 am and 6.00 pm
- Children enrolled in Holy Family Catholic School or another primary school are eligible to attend the program.
- Children must be enrolled in the service, and bookings must be requested via the Xplor app.
- Bookings are subject to availability and licencing requirements.
- A Vacation Care agreement must be signed to attend the holiday program.
- Cancellation of bookings must be advised with 24 hours notice otherwise will be charged full fees.
- Please ensure that all children are signed in and out each day.
- Please ensure that all medication/health support requirements have been notified to the staff with a medication and/or health support plan.
- Spending money will not be required unless stated as an option on the Vacation Care program.
- Planned activities including incursions and excursions may be cancelled in the case of inclement weather or any other event at the discretion of OSHC staff.
- We will aim to adhere to the program as much as possible but circumstances do sometimes occur that require changes to schedule, eg. weather.

Meals

- Please ensure that your child has a packed recess and lunch each day unless specified in the program.
- Please bring a water bottle each day.
- Please bring a hat each day.
- We ask that noodles or any lunch that requires heating up or boiling water is not sent due to our Duty of Care policy.
- Products containing nuts are not permitted in the school eg peanut butter, Nutella, muesli bars

Clothing/Property

- Please ensure your child is wearing appropriate clothing according to the weather and daily activities.
- Please ensure that clothing is labelled with your child's name so it can be returned promptly.
- We have a hat and sunscreen policy, please ensure that your child has a hat in terms 1 and 4 and if they can't use our sunscreen, please provide your own.

Childcare Subsidy

You may be eligible to receive Childcare Subsidy. Further information can be obtained from Centrelink.

Conditions of Booking

Behaviour Management

At Holy Family OSHC all children are expected to follow the Service's rules and guidelines. These are posted up on the information board in the Service. If rules are broken, reasonable consequences will follow. In the case of a disruptive child, the Director will discuss the issue with the parents or caregivers.

Please note: The Service reserves the right to terminate enrolment if inappropriate behaviour continues after reasonable measures have been taken to involve the child positively.

When we go on excursion, we are representing Holy Family Catholic School and therefore it is an expectation that the children behave safely.

Our policy on excursions is that in the event of inappropriate behaviour that may pose a safety risk to the child concerned or any other child at the service exclusion from excursion activities may result. If this behaviour occurs whilst on excursion, you will need to collect your child from the excursion venue.

Excursion and Incursion

At Holy Family OSHC all children must have parental consent to attend the excursions and incursion. A parental consent form must be signed before the excursion and/or incursion. Please collect the consent form for bookings made for an excursion or incursion day from the OSHC office.

Cancellations

Cancellation of bookings must be advised with 24 hours notice otherwise will be charged full fees. If we are not informed of an absence and/or by the required time, the session fee will apply.

Bookings

To book a spot for your child/children, please use the Xplor Home app. If your family has not used our service before and you wish to make a booking, kindly fill out the online inquiry form by following this link, and then download the Xplor Home app. You will receive a confirmation email containing the details needed to enrol your child/children. After completing the enrollment process, you will be able to register on the Xplor Home app to make a booking.
